This month at North Main, we will be exploring a theme entitled "Preserving Patience." This is patience that preserves the purposes and plans of GOD. From Balaam and his talking donkey (Numbers 22), to the Cycles of "Sin, Slavery, Sorrow, and Salvation" in Judges (Judges 2), we will learn about the various ways GOD preserved His people and His plans for redemption of humanity. The messages in this series are as follows:

- March 6 Sermon Title: Balaam's Talking Donkey Sermon Scripture: Numbers 22:21-41 Key Point: "GOD's protection preserves His perfect plans as He patiently contends with adversaries."
- March 13 Sermon Title: Wholehearted Commitment Sermon Scripture: Deuteronomy 6:1-25 Key Point: "Wholehearted commitment to GOD's commands is a means to blessing and preservation of life."
- March 20 Sermon Title: Life or Death Sermon Scripture: Deuteronomy 30:11-20 Key Point: "GOD has given us a choice between life or death. Oh, that we would choose life!"
